The first Step to be taken in this Case, is, if the Humour be fit to be purged off, to exhibit some evacuating Medicine, which may bring away the Remains of the former Disease. If this be not done, either an Abscess or a Relapse will ensue. This Medicine ought always to be prepared according to the Nature of the Matter, and the Measure of the Srength. All Vomiting is useless, unless some corrupt Humour has seized upon the Stomach. Oftentimes the Vessels are conveniently purged by such

Medicines as are endued with a diuretick Quality. This Method must be pursued, when Nature seem...
