

These, as well as the main Trunk, towards their Extremities, are cloathed with many large digitated Leaves upon reddish Footstalks, of about Six Inches long. _ The Flowers are deeply divided into Five Sections, whose Edges are tinged with a pale Purple. Out of the Centre rise Eight Stanzina, tipped with yellow sarinaceous Apzsices. Five of these Stanzina fall back, and lean against the different Sections, The Flowers are succeeded by many small round green Berries, whose Outside is divided into Five selvaged Seams, the Inside containing Three blackish Seeds. The Method of making Bread from the Roots is, first, to grate them very fine, and press out theJuice, and dry the mealy Part in the Sun; and then make it into thin Loaves, like those made with Oatmeal in many of the Country Parts of England, Scotland, and Wales. This Bread is well tasted, and nourishing; and, by its absorbent Alality, it ishighly serviceable to Persons of a plethoric Habit, or inclinable to Dropsies.. The Juice is a quick mortal Poison to every Animal. Having tried an Experiment upon Two half-grown Fowls, by pouring down their Throats Two Tea-spoonfuls of this Juice, newly expressed, it soon threw them into Convulsions; and they both died in about half an Hours time.
