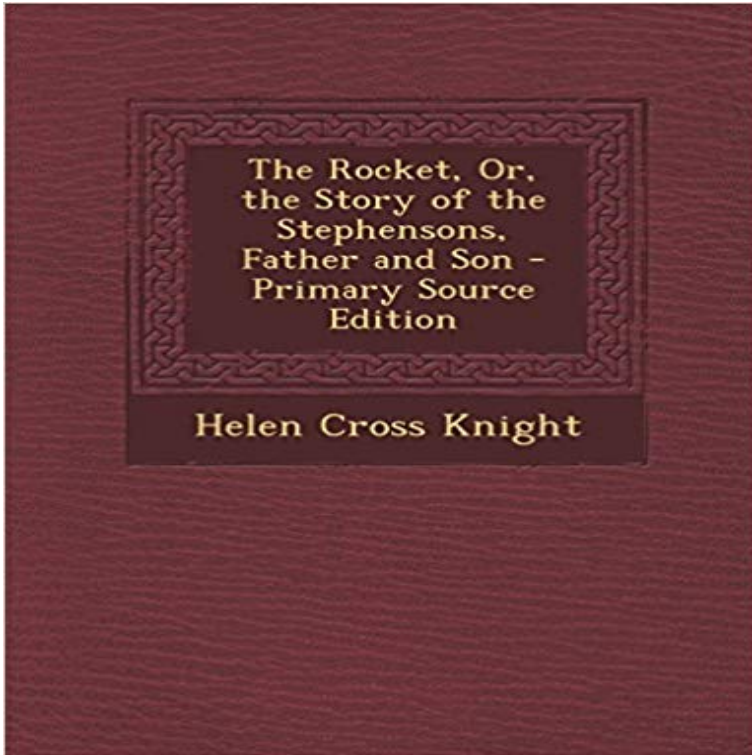


# The Rocket, Or, the Story of the Stephensons, Father and Son - Primary Source Edition
