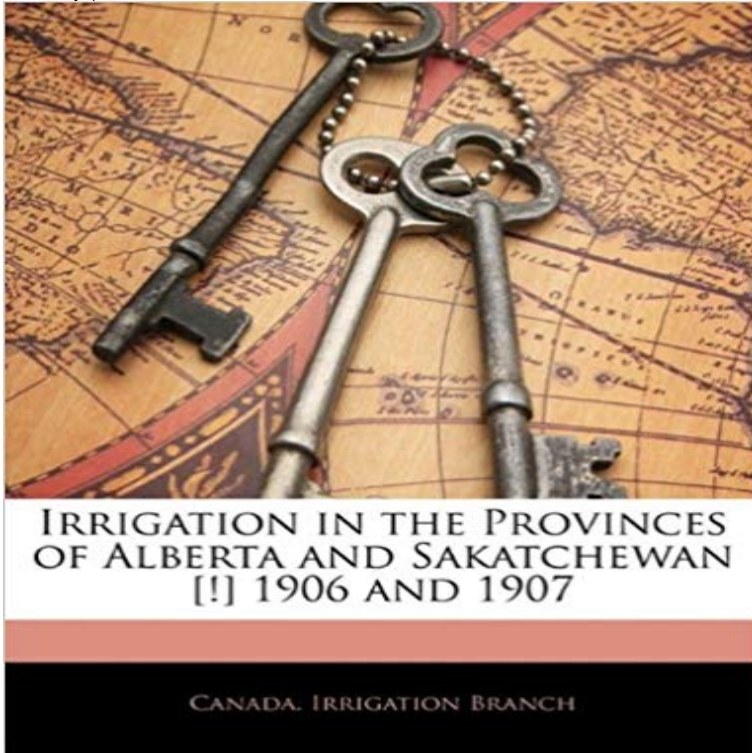


## Irrigation in the Provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan [!] 1906 and 1907
