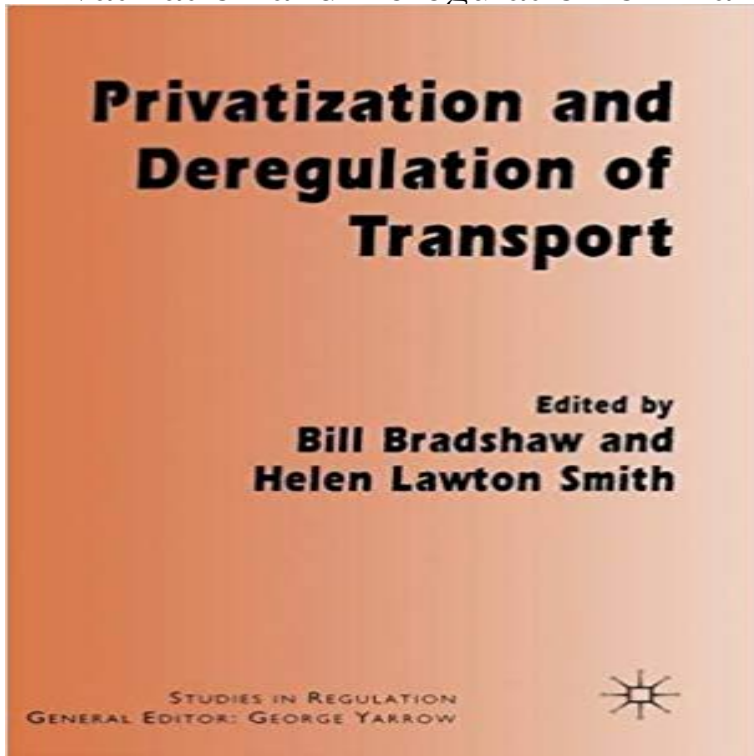


Privatization and Deregulation of Transport (Studies in Regulation)
